***NOTE TO GRADUATE STUDENTS:** If you enroll in more credits than the minimum F-1/J-1 requirement for full-time, your tuition and fee charges may be higher than what is listed here.

²Graduate Assistant's portion of the Mandatory Health Insurance is estimated at \$840.

³If **accompanied by dependent** spouse or children, you are fully responsible for their support and additional funds are required. The cost of insurance for a dependent is equal to the cost of the student. Graduate rate listed. University assistantship stipends are not sufficient to cover dependent expenses and are not intended to do so.

The high cost of child care for children ages 0-6 years is not included in the child expenses figures.

⁴Graduate Assistant child dependent expenses are \$4,600 (Living \$3,550 + Insurance \$1,050 @ 25%) for each of the first 2 children, with a maximum of \$2,100 insurance for 3 or more children.

⁵Masters of Engineering program is one full year including fall, spring, and summer semesters. Students are required to show financial guarantee funding for 12 months living + summer tuition.

SUMMER ESTIMATES - Full-time summer expenses are figured by adding \$600 (books and supplies), \$500-\$1000 (fees), and the amount of your tuition which is 9 times the summer per credit cost for graduates and 12 times the summer per credit cost for undergraduates.
