1

DETERMINE WHICH REQUIREMENTS YOU STILL NEED TO FULFILL

Complete a "What If Report" or Academic Requirement

Audit in LionPATH to determine which Penn State requirements you still need to fulfill. You can reference the Undergraduate University Bulletin for an explanation of the General Education requirements (GA, GH, etc.)

RESEARCH APPROPRIATE COURSES ABROAD

To find a list of courses offered by your program, go to the Education Abroad website under the "Students" tab and "Academics" option. For questions on how to find courses abroad, contact an education abroad adviser.

BEGIN FILLING OUT THE EA COURSE PLANNING TOOL

Use the information on the academic tab of your program's page to determine the number of courses to take, view the program historical course list to begin filling out the course planning tool. Confirm this plan with an academic adviser.

MEET WITH AN ACADEMIC ADVISER

Once you have a good idea of what courses you need to take and what courses are offered in your study abroad program, consult with your academic adviser to discuss your academic plan for education abroad.
